Drop Off

- Please walk Kindergarten and TK students to the daycare classroom (Room 301, Mrs. Trice/Art Room) before 8:00 a.m.
- You may drop off Kindergarten and TK students from 8:00 a.m. 8:30 a.m. on the Kindergarten playground. Kindergarten students may also use the drop off line, where a staff member will help them to the playground.
- Daycare for $1^{st} 5^{th}$ grade students before 8:00 a.m. will be in the lunchroom.




