Drop Off

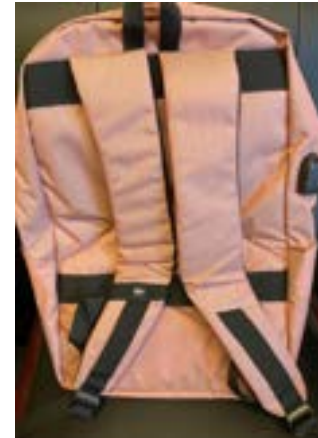
- ◆ Please walk Kindergarten and TK students to the daycare classroom (Room 301, Mrs. Trice/Art Room) before 8:00 a.m.
- ◆ You may drop off Kindergarten and TK students from 8:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. on the Kindergarten playground. Kindergarten students may also use the drop off line, where a staff member will help them to the playground.
- ◆ Daycare for 1st – 5th grade students before 8:00 a.m. will be in the lunchroom.
- ◆ From 8:00 a.m. - 8:20 a.m. 1st through 5th grade students may be dropped off in the car line. After 8:20 a.m. please send students to the office to check in. Junior High students are considered tardy after 8:10 a.m.
- ◆ Please **DO NOT** drop off students in front of the playground or foyer area. Please **PULL ALL THE WAY FORWARD TO AN ADULT.**
- ◆ **Please only turn right out of the parking lot to prevent cars from getting backed up. Don't be "THAT" person.....**

Pick Up

- ◆ Please pick up Kindergarten and TK students in the pickup line between 2:40 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.
- ◆ Kindergarten and TK students will be located in the cafeteria from 2:45 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.
- ◆ 1st and 2nd grades may be picked up in the car line from 3:00 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.
- ◆ 3rd - 5th grades may be picked up in the car line from 3:15 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.
- ◆ 6th – 8th grades may be picked up in the car line from 2:30 – 3:30 p.m.

6th – 8th Grade Backpack Requirement

- 6th – 8th grade students may only use a cinch/drawstring bag or a school issued backpack. Other backpacks must be kept in the locker.
- You may purchase a backpack at school for \$35 (different colors, billed to account) or use the backpack you purchased last year.
- Students must keep their Chrome Book in their provided cases.

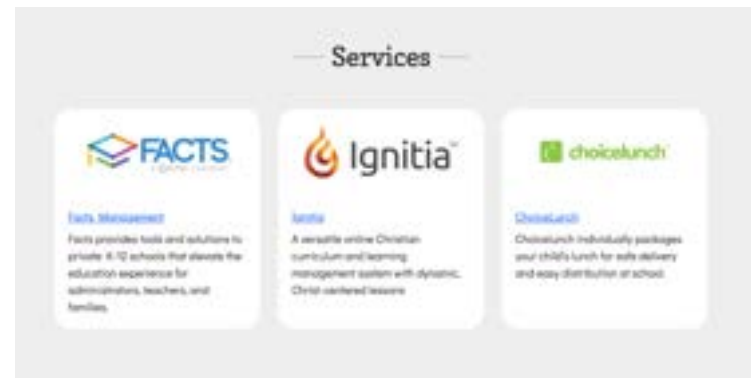

Facts Account

Tabernacle uses the Facts Management Program for all our student, family and billing information. A link can be found on our school website, under the Family tab.

All 6th – 8th grade students are also given their own personal Facts account to help them keep track of their assignments and grades. These do not have financial information on them.

The older the student gets the more parents will use Facts for checking grades and class lesson plans (3rd – 8th), classroom documents, behavior reports (if any) and billing.
